

Upstream Prevention, Inc's Privacy Policy

Upstream Prevention takes privacy of our volunteers, members, and recoverees seriously. The following privacy policy applies to all initiatives under Upstream's umbrella, including the Suicide Prevention Coalition, ATLAS, RISE, Recovery Café JoCo, and any training or event hosted by Upstream or one of our initiatives.

Upon enrolling or attending an event, Upstream will likely present a chance for you to share your contact information. Typically, this contact information is your name, occupation, job title/organization, email address. We may also collect your phone number, demographic information, or other information as required by our grants. If you're submitting a payment or donation, we'll additionally collect your address and a third-party processor will collect your payment information.

For event registration or enrollment online, this information will be collected via a form on the donation or enrollment page. For membership or attendance at in-person events (without pre-registration) this information will be collected via a paper form in person at the event.

Typically, this information is needed for various grant and reporting requirements Upstream must abide by in our grants and contracts. Occasionally, this information will also be used to monitor attendance and identify potential positive outcomes as a result of your participation. Unless otherwise noted, all data collected will only be shared publicly in aggregate form, and will never include contact information.

Contact information is collected so Upstream can connect with you to keep you updated on changes to the event or activity you registered for, potential upcoming events you may be interested in, and to ensure you have a way to reach out to Upstream if any challenges arise. We will not share your contact information beyond Upstream and our core team who needs to be able to reach you. Your information is never shared with third parties/affiliates for marketing/promotional purposes.

All sharing mentioned in this policy excludes mobile opt-in and consent; opt-in information is never shared with anyone for any purpose.

Individuals can always unsubscribe from communications. If you're receiving texts, you can text/reply STOP; if you're receiving emails, you can click the "Unsubscribe" button at the bottom of the email.
